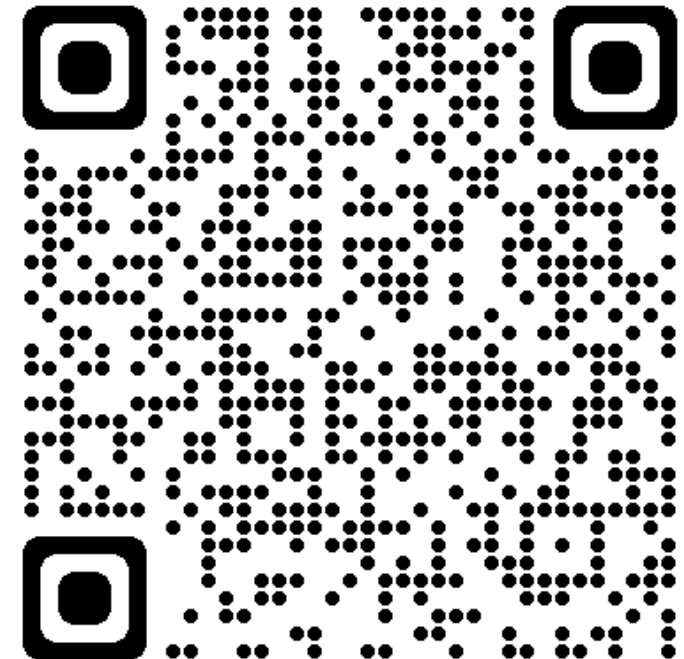

What is Access2Markets?

- **Free online tool** supporting companies in their efforts to **internationalise**, launched in **October 2020**
- Information on import/export of **products, trade statistics, and trade agreements** in 151 export markets and nearly all import markets
- Breaks down the legal language into **practical information**
- **Interactive, multilingual**, with Videos + tutorials
- Regular **updates**

My Trade Assistant Services and Investment

- Includes **requirements** for the export of certain services
- Acts as a **primary source of information**, providing references to regulations and details about the relevant authorities
- **Twelve countries:** Brazil, Canada, China, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Mexico, Norway, South Africa, Switzerland, United Kingdom, and the USA
- **100 service sectors** per country
- Further expansions planned



My Trade Assistant Procurement

- **Assessment** of the possibility for EU companies to participate in public tenders in third countries
- **Five countries:** Canada, Japan, Switzerland, United Kingdom, and the USA
- Information included in the tender notice: **contract authority**, **subject**, and estimated **contract value**
- Includes direct links to **legal texts** and additional information sources
