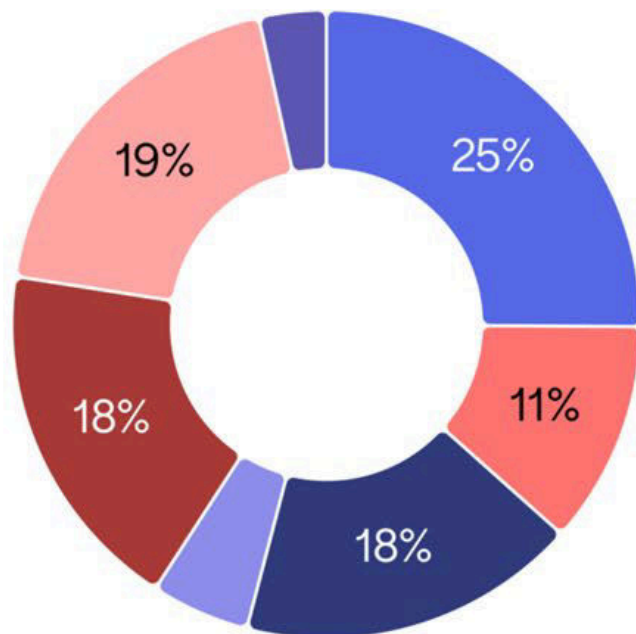
# 1. What is the main challenge to building sustainable modernized systems?



## 2. What can you/your organization bring to public health data modernization?

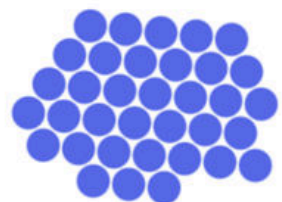


### 3. Where have you seen successes in public health data modernization so far?

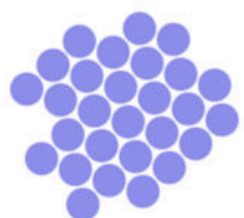
