- Trade facilitation (added later)

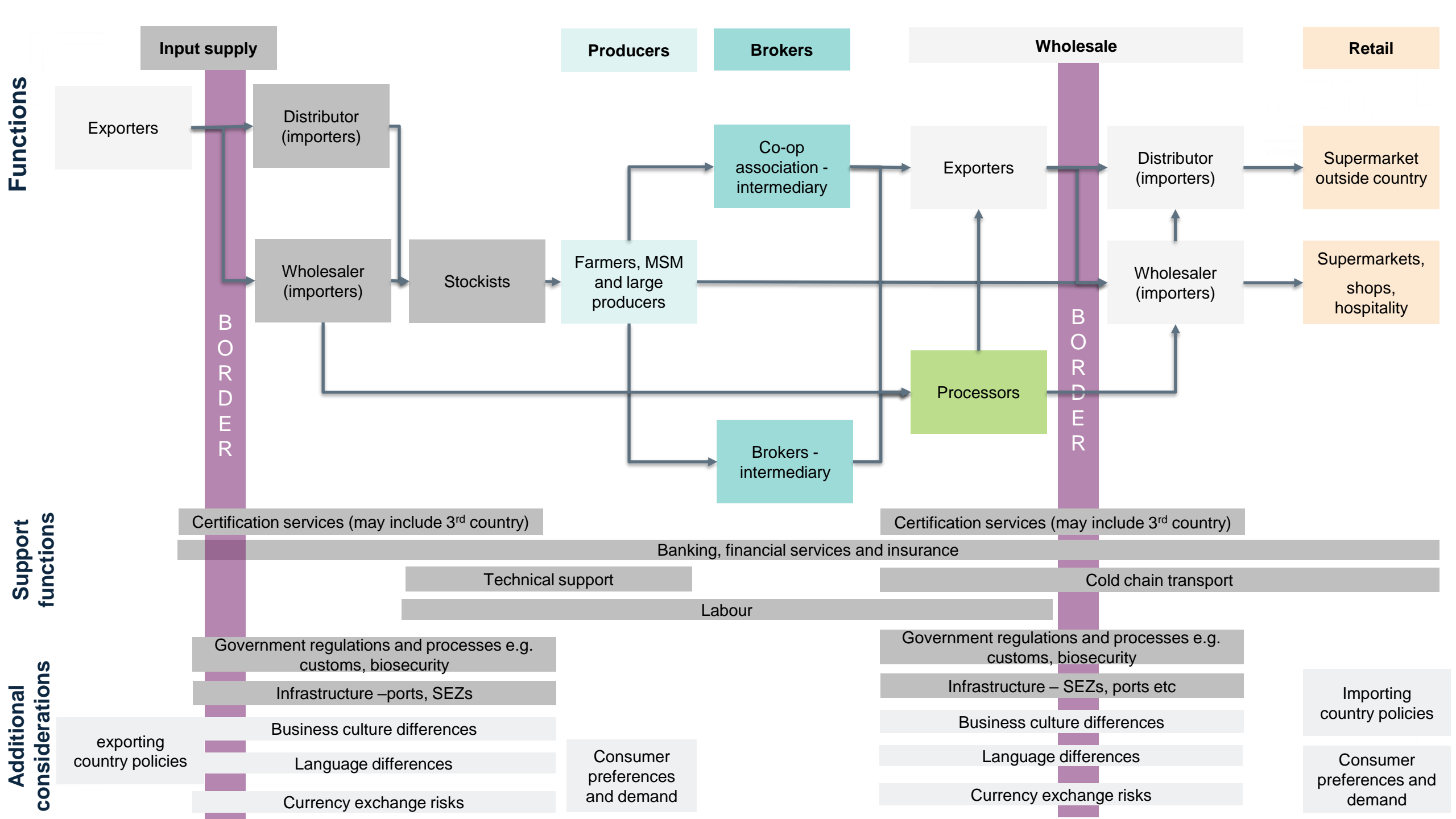
Missing – imports

- Production & marketing of commodities, food crops, livestock products
 - Development of service exports
 - Increasing cross-border, regional and global trade
 - Improving government trade facilitation
 - Addressing issues related to imports, e.g. related to agriculture productivity like fertiliser or machinery
 - Encouraging inward investment to help drive export growth and development
 - Financing small-scale infrastructure investments to enable or facilitate trade
