SESSION 6: OVERVIEW OF INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES ON RENEWABLE ENERGY IN MOZAMBIQUE

Day 2 – 10 June 2026 – 10:30-12:00

Summary

This panel will present Mozambique's strategic investment opportunities across the energy sector. It will provide a clear overview of the country's/RENMOZ's energy projects pipeline and how these opportunities align with national priorities for expanding generation capacity, strengthening transmission and distribution networks, and scaling up off-grid solutions. The session will guide investors through the most relevant projects, how they are being structured and what type of private sector participation is envisaged, and how they fit within Mozambique's broader energy transition and electrification goals. Speakers will also outline the role of international partnerships in supporting implementation and scaling impact.

Context

Mozambique's energy sector is at a decisive moment, where exceptional resource potential, rising demand, and strong policy ambition are converging to create one of the most compelling renewable energy investment opportunities in Sub-Saharan Africa.

Mozambique is no longer only defining its ambitions, it is actively building a pipeline of investable projects across: (i) utility-scale generation: solar, hydro, and emerging wind projects, with multi-gigawatt targets for 2030; (ii) transmission infrastructure: critical corridors to connect resource-rich regions and integrate the national grid; and (iii) off-grid and decentralized solutions: essential to reach rural populations where grid extension is not immediately viable. This reflects a shift from strategy to execution, where the key challenge is no longer identifying opportunities, but structuring, financing, and delivering them at scale.

A single pipeline document is currently being prepared in collaboration with FUNAE, EDM, HCB, GMNK, and the national roadshow for RENMOZ, that it will be presented in detail during the RENMOZ business sessions.

Session Objectives

- Advance the implementation of Mozambique's national strategy for expanding renewable energy generation, strengthening grid infrastructure, and increasing energy access.
- Showcase a robust pipeline of priority projects across generation, transmission, and off-grid solutions and C&I, and open them to investment.
- Facilitate the participation of national and European developers, technology providers, and investors in project implementation.
